श्री बाबा मस्तनाथ मठ का संक्षिप्त परिचय

उत्तर भारत के हरियाणा प्रांत में रोहतक की पावन धरा अस्थल बोहर पर परमसिद्ध शिरोमणि चौरंगीनाथ जी महाराज की तपोस्थली संपूर्ण भारत वर्ष में प्रसिद्ध है। अस्थल बोहर का यह प्राचीन मठ आठवीं शताब्दी से लेकर अब तक सामाजिक, धार्मिक तथा सांस्कृतिक उपलब्धियों का जीवंत स्थल है। भारत देश के इतिहास में नाथ संप्रदाय के इस स्थल का अत्यंत महत्वपूर्ण स्थान है। यह मठ आमजन व संतों को दीक्षित करके आत्म-साक्षात्कार तथा जनकल्याण में प्रवृत्त होने की प्रेरणा देता आया है। यहाँ से शिक्षा प्राप्त करके अनेक मनीषियों ने केवल उत्तर भारत में ही नहीं, अपितु संपूर्ण विश्व में ज्ञान का प्रचार-प्रसार कर यहाँ का परचम लहराया है। इस मठ में बाबा मस्तनाथ जी महाराज ने कई वर्षों तक कठोर तपस्या से अपार सिद्धियों को प्राप्त कर जनमानस के अनेक कष्टों का निवारण किया। संत परंपरा के अन्तर्गत यहाँ परम सिद्ध तोतानाथ जी, योगीराज मेघनाथ जी, श्री मोहरनाथ जी, श्री चेतनाथ जी, श्री पूर्णनाथ जी, महंत श्रेयोनाथ जी, महंत चाँदनाथ योगी जी और वर्तमान गद्दीनशीन, महंत बालकनाथ जी योगी हैं। बीसवीं सदी में अस्थल बोहर गद्दी के महंत श्री श्रेयोनाथ जी नाड़ी विज्ञान के जाने-माने वैद्य थे। वे वर्ष 1978 ई० में हरियाणा सरकार के स्वास्थ्य मंत्री भी रहे। महंत श्रेयोनाथ जी महाराज ने वर्ष 1957 में श्री बाबा मस्तनाथ आयुर्वेदिक महाविद्यालय की स्थापना कर चिकित्सा के क्षेत्र में एक पौधरोपण किया था। इस आयुर्वेदिक महाविद्यालय की स्थापना का उद्देश्य समाज के कमजोर वर्ग के इलाज हेतु किया गया था। उत्तर भारत में आयुर्वेदिक शिक्षा के क्षेत्र में पहला महाविद्यालय है। वर्तमान समय में इस महाविद्यालय के अन्तर्गत 110 बेड का सभी आधुनिक सुविधाओं से परिपूर्ण एक अस्पताल भी संचालित है। उन्होंने चिकित्सा कि बेहतर सुविधाओं को ध्यान में रखते हुए आँखों के अस्पताल का निर्माण भी करवाया, जिसके तहत केवल आस-पास के क्षेत्र ही नहीं, अपितु अन्य राज्यों के मरीज भी यहाँ चिकित्सा सुविधा के लिए आते हैं। वर्ष 1977 ई० में दिल्ली के बेगमपुर गाँव के साधारण किसान परिवार में जन्मे चाँदनाथ जी ने दिल्ली विश्वविद्यालय से बी.ए. (ऑनर्स) की उपाधि प्राप्त करने के बाद गृहस्थ जीवन में कोई रुचि न होने के कारण अस्थल बोहर मठ का आश्रय पाकर महंत श्रेयोनाथ जी महाराज को अपना गुरु बना, शिष्य परम्परा का निर्वहन किया। महंत श्रेयोनाथ जी चाहते थे कि कोई कर्मठ एवं शिक्षित साधु इस गद्दी का वारिस बने। इस रूप में उन्होंने योगी चाँदनाथ जी को अपने उत्तराधिकारी के रूप में चुना। महंत चाँदनाथ जी योगी ने शिक्षा और स्वास्थ्य के क्षेत्र में अनेक उत्कृष्ट कार्य करके 'विधेयम् जन सेवनम्' का संदेश दिया। बाबा मस्तनाथ विश्वविद्यालय के वर्तमान कुलाधिपति, महंत बालकनाथ जी योगी इस विश्वविद्यालय को शिक्षा, स्वास्थ्य, अध्यात्म और योग के एक विशिष्ट केंद्र के रूप में विकसित करने के लिए सर्वोत्तम प्रयास कर रहे हैं।

महंत बालकनाथ जी योगी की देखरेख में बाबा मस्तनाथ मठ का अक्षरधाम मंदिर (दिल्ली) की तर्ज पर निर्माण कराया जा रहा है। इस मंदिर के अन्दर 186 खम्बे लगाए जा रहे हैं। मंदिर की ऊँचाई 108 फीट रहेगी। साथ ही, मंदिर की चौड़ाई 250 फीट और लम्बाई 300 फीट है। इस पूरे मंदिर के निर्माण में 5 लाख 50 हजार घन फीट पत्थर का इस्तेमाल किया जाएगा। यह मंदिर भविष्य में रोहतक के लिए मील का पत्थर साबित होगा तथा बाहर से आने वाले श्रद्धालुओं व दर्शनार्थियों के लिए आकर्षण का केन्द्र बनेगा तथा इस मंदिर के निर्माण से विश्व में रोहतक का नाम गौरवान्वित होगा। यह मंदिर लगभग 35 एकड़ में बनेगा, जिससे आगन्तुक श्रद्धालुओं को किसी भी प्रकार की समस्या का सामना न करना पड़े। इस मठ का निर्माण कार्य लगभग 85 प्रतिशत पूर्ण हो चुका है, बाकि बचा हुआ कार्य भी अतिशीघ्र पूरा कर लिया जाएगा।

ब्रह्मलीन महंत चाँदनाथ जी योगी

संस्थापक कुलाधिपति

योगी चाँदनाथ जी सच्चे संत और अच्छे सद्गुरु थे। वे ज्ञान के पुंज थे। इतना ही नहीं, वे अलौकिक संत, महान कर्मयोगी, महान तपस्वी और समाजसेवी थे। योगी चाँदनाथ का जन्म वर्ष 21 जून, 1956 को दिल्ली के बेगमपुर गाँव के साधारण किसान परिवार में हुआ था। उनके पिता का नाम श्री मोहर सिंह व माता का नाम श्रीमती चम्पा देवी था। वे सात भाई-बहनों में सबसे बड़े थे तथा बचपन से ही कुशाग्रबुद्धि और आध्यात्मिक विचारों के थे। घर-गृहस्थी से अलग होकर वे साधना कर्म में संलग्न रहते थे।

योगी चाँदनाथ जी ने वर्ष 1977 में दिल्ली विश्वविद्यालय से बी.ए. ऑनर्स की उपाधि प्राप्त की तथा वर्ष 1978 में वे शिक्षा, धर्म व अध्यात्म के केन्द्र अस्थल बोहर मठ के महंत श्री श्रेयोनाथ जी को अपना गुरु बनाकर शिष्य परम्परा का निर्वहन किया। महंत श्री श्रेयोनाथ जी उन दिनों किसी योग्य उत्तराधिकारी की तलाश में थे। उनकी यह तलाश योगी चाँदनाथ को शिष्य रूप में पाकर पूर्ण हो गई और महंत श्री श्रेयोनाथ जी को इनमें अस्थल बोहर मठ का भविष्य नजर आने लगा। फलतः शिष्य की प्रशासनिक कार्य क्षमता परखने के लिए हनुमानगढ़ मठ के कोठारी का उत्तरदायित्व उन्हें सौंपा। हनुमानगढ़ में जनता की स्वास्थ्य सम्बन्धी परेशानियों को देखते हुए नेत्र चिकित्सालय, सामान्य चिकित्सालय, एक शिव मंदिर का निर्माण करवाकर जनसेवक एवं धर्मसेवक होने का परिचय दिया। योगी चाँदनाथ की कार्यक्षमता, कार्यशैली दोनों ही महंत श्री श्रेयोनाथ जी को अच्छी लगी और उन्होंने मन में विचार किया कि मठ की समृद्धि के लिए जीवित रहते किसी योग्य उत्तराधिकारी का चयन आवश्यक है। वर्ष 1984 में महंत श्री श्रेयोनाथ ने योगी चाँदनाथ को अस्थल बोहर मठ का उत्तराधिकारी घोषित किया। वर्ष 1985 में महंत श्री श्रेयोनाथ के समाधिनीन होने पर महंत के रूप में योगी महंत चाँदनाथ ने मठ के विकास कार्यों को गति प्रदान की। महंत योगी चाँदनाथ जी ने ‘विधेयम् जन सेवनम्’ के मार्ग का अनुसरण करते हुए धर्म, शिक्षा, चिकित्सा को अपना कर्म क्षेत्र बनाया। वर्ष 1986 में उन्होंने एक विद्यालय से इसकी शुरुआत की तथा वर्ष 2012 में अपने संस्थान को विश्वविद्यालय का दर्जा दिलवाया जो विश्वविद्यालय अनुदान आयोग द्वारा मान्यता प्राप्त है।

वर्ष 1986 में अपने गुरुजी महंत श्री श्रेयोनाथ जी की समाधि स्थल का निर्माण, वर्ष 1987 में सिविल रोड, रोहतक में पब्लिक स्कूल की स्थापना, वर्ष 1988 में अस्थल बोहर, मठ में अवासीय पब्लिक स्कूल की स्थापना, वर्ष 1989 में बाबा मस्तनाथ सभागार का निर्माण, वर्ष 1990 में शिव मन्दिर की स्थापना, वर्ष 1991 में प्राचीन शिवमन्दिर का जीर्णोद्धार, वर्ष 1992 में थेहड़ी डेरे के मन्दिर का निर्माण, वर्ष 1993 चक 7 एल. एल. का निर्माण, वर्ष 1994 में श्री ब्रह्मनाथ धर्मशाला का निर्माण, वर्ष 1995 में एम.बी.ए. कॉलेज की स्थापना, वर्ष 1996 में फार्मसी एवं डी.एड. कॉलेज की स्थापना, वर्ष 1997 में डेंटल एवं इंजिनियरिंग कॉलेज की स्थापना, वर्ष 1998 में फिजियोथेरेपी एवं मॉडर्न साइंसेज कॉलेज की स्थापना, वर्ष 1999 में संस्कृत महाविद्यालय की स्थापना, वर्ष 2000 में नर्सिंग कॉलेज की स्थापना, वर्ष 2001 में कन्या छात्रावास का निर्माण कराया। इसी वर्ष महंत योगी चाँदनाथ जी योगी को उनके विशेष कार्यों के लिए इन्दिरा गाँधी अवार्ड से सम्मानित किया गया। वर्ष 2002 में श्री रणपतमानधाता जी की समाधि स्थल का निर्माण, वर्ष 2003 में रैबारी धर्मशाला का निर्माण। वर्ष 2004 में महंत योगी चाँदनाथ जी महाराज को राजस्थान सरकार द्वारा ‘शिक्षा रत्न’ से सम्मानित किया गया तथा इसी वर्ष महंत चाँदनाथ योगी बहरोड़ विधानसभा क्षेत्र से विधायक बने और अपने कार्यकौशल से वहाँ की व्यवस्थाओं को दुरुस्त कर कायाकल्प किया। वर्ष 2005 में चिकित्सा भवन तथा छात्रावास-2 का निर्माण, वर्ष 2006 में बाबा मस्तनाथ जी महाराज की विशाल प्रतिमा का निर्माण। वर्ष 2007 में महंत योगी चाँदनाथ जी को राजस्थान सरकार द्वारा राजस्थान गौरव अवार्ड से सम्मानित किया गया। वर्ष 2008 में बी.एड. महाविद्यालयों की, अस्थल बोहर, रोहतक, हरियाणा एवं हनुमानगढ़, राजस्थान में स्थापना, वर्ष 2009 में एम. टेक, एम. फार्मा, कोर्सों का प्रारम्भ, वर्ष 2010 में सिद्ध शिरोमणि बाबा मस्तनाथ जी महाराज के समाधि मन्दिर की नींव रखी गई एवं एम.सी.ए. व सिविल इंजिनियरिंग के कोर्स प्रारम्भ किये गये। वर्ष 2011 में बाबा मस्तनाथ पॉलिटेक्निक संस्थान की स्थापना, वर्ष 2012 में बाबा मस्तनाथ विश्वविद्यालय की स्थापना, वर्ष 2013 में बाबा मस्तनाथ विश्वविद्यालय में विधि-विभाग की स्थापना की। वर्ष 2014 में महंत योगी चाँदनाथ जी अलवर लोकसभा क्षेत्र, राजस्थान से सांसद चुने गए। वर्ष 2016 में 5 वर्षीय एम.बी.ए. तथा बी. एससी. केमिस्ट्री ऑनर्स के कोर्स प्रारम्भ हुए।

वर्ष 2016 में अपनी दूरदर्शिता का परिचय देते हुए अपने अनेक शिष्यों में से कर्मठ, ईमानदार, योग्य एवं अनुभवी शिष्य बालकनाथ जी योगी को बाबा मस्तनाथ मठ का उत्तराधिकारी बनाया। यदि विकास की दृष्टि से अवलोकन किया जाए तो इस मठ में निर्माण कार्य कभी बन्द होता ही नहीं है। वर्तमान समय में भी लगभग 170 करोड़ रुपये की लागत से अक्षरधाम मंदिर की तर्ज पर एक भव्य मंदिर का निर्माण कार्य चल रहा है, जो अपने आप में अनूठा समाधि स्थल और भव्य मंदिर होगा।

महंत योगी चाँदनाथ जी दिव्य एवं अलौकिक संत थे, जो जन्म व मृत्यु के रहस्य को भी भलीभाँति जानते थे, परन्तु विधि के विधान को कौन टाल सकता है जिसने इस नश्वर शरीर को धारण किया है, हर किसी को उस परमतत्त्व में विलीन होना पड़ता है। इस कालक्रम के प्रवाह में वर्ष 2015 में परमपूज्य महंत योगी चाँदनाथ जी महाराज को एक भयावह बीमारी ने घेर लिया, जिसके चलते 17 सितंबर, 2017 चैत्र सुदी द्वादशी को वे ब्रह्मलीन हो गए।

महंत योगी चाँदनाथ जी ने स्वयं के लिए कभी नहीं सोचा, अपितु शिक्षा के माध्यम से वे लाखों लोगों की सेवा करने के लिए हमेशा कार्यरत रहे। वास्तव में, वे सच्चे शिक्षाविद और प्रेरणा स्रोत रहे। उन्होंने अपना जीवन जरूरतमंदों की सेवा एवं उनके उत्थान में लगाया। वे एक सच्चे कर्मयोगी थे। वास्तव में उनके जीवन से लाखों लोगों को प्रेरणा मिलती रहेगी। भले ही वे आज हमारे बीच पार्थिव रूप में नहीं हैं, परन्तु प्रेरणा-स्वरूप वे हमारे साथ हमेशा विद्यमान रहेंगे।

सिद्ध शिरोमणि श्री बाबा मस्तनाथ जी महाराज की तपोस्थली के पावन प्रांगण में मेरे दादा गुरु योगीराज श्रीयुत महंत श्रेयोनाथ जी द्वारा शिक्षा के क्षेत्र में लगाये गये एकमात्र पौधे को मेरे पूज्य गुरुदेव महंत श्री चाँदनाथ जी महाराज ने अपनी दूर दृष्टि, कड़ी मेहनत, लगन एवं कर्मठता से एक वट वृक्ष का रूप दिया अर्थात् उन्होंने एक मात्र शिक्षण संस्थान से बाबा मस्तनाथ विश्वविद्यालय बनाया, जिसमें आज 9 संकाय एवं 80 से अधिक पाठ्यक्रम चल रहे हैं। पूज्य गुरुदेव के द्वारा बताये गये रास्ते पर चलते हुए मैं इस विश्वविद्यालय को उन्नति के सर्वोत्तम शिखर पर ले जाने के लिए भरसक प्रयत्न कर रहा हूँ, ताकि देश ही नहीं, बल्कि विदेशों में भी बाबा मस्तनाथ विश्वविद्यालय का नाम बड़े सम्मान और विश्वसनीयता के साथ लिया जाये।

मैं इस विश्वविद्यालय में शिक्षा, चिकित्सा, अध्यात्म, संस्कृति, योग एवं नैतिकता के भव्य भवन को निर्मित करने के लिए कुछ ऐसे विशिष्ट कार्य कर रहा हूँ; ताकि इससे जुड़ा हुआ हर कर्मचारी, अधिकारी, विद्यार्थी एवं समाज इससे जुड़ने में अपनी आन-बान एवं शान समझें। इतना ही नहीं, विश्वविद्यालय की प्रत्येक पाठ्यचर्या को परम्परा तथा आधुनिकता से सम्बद्ध करने का कार्य भी प्राथमिकता के आधार पर रखा गया है। पूज्य गुरुदेव की मान्यता थी कि समाज को शिक्षित करने से बड़ी कोई तपस्या नहीं है। इसलिए वे कहते थे कि-

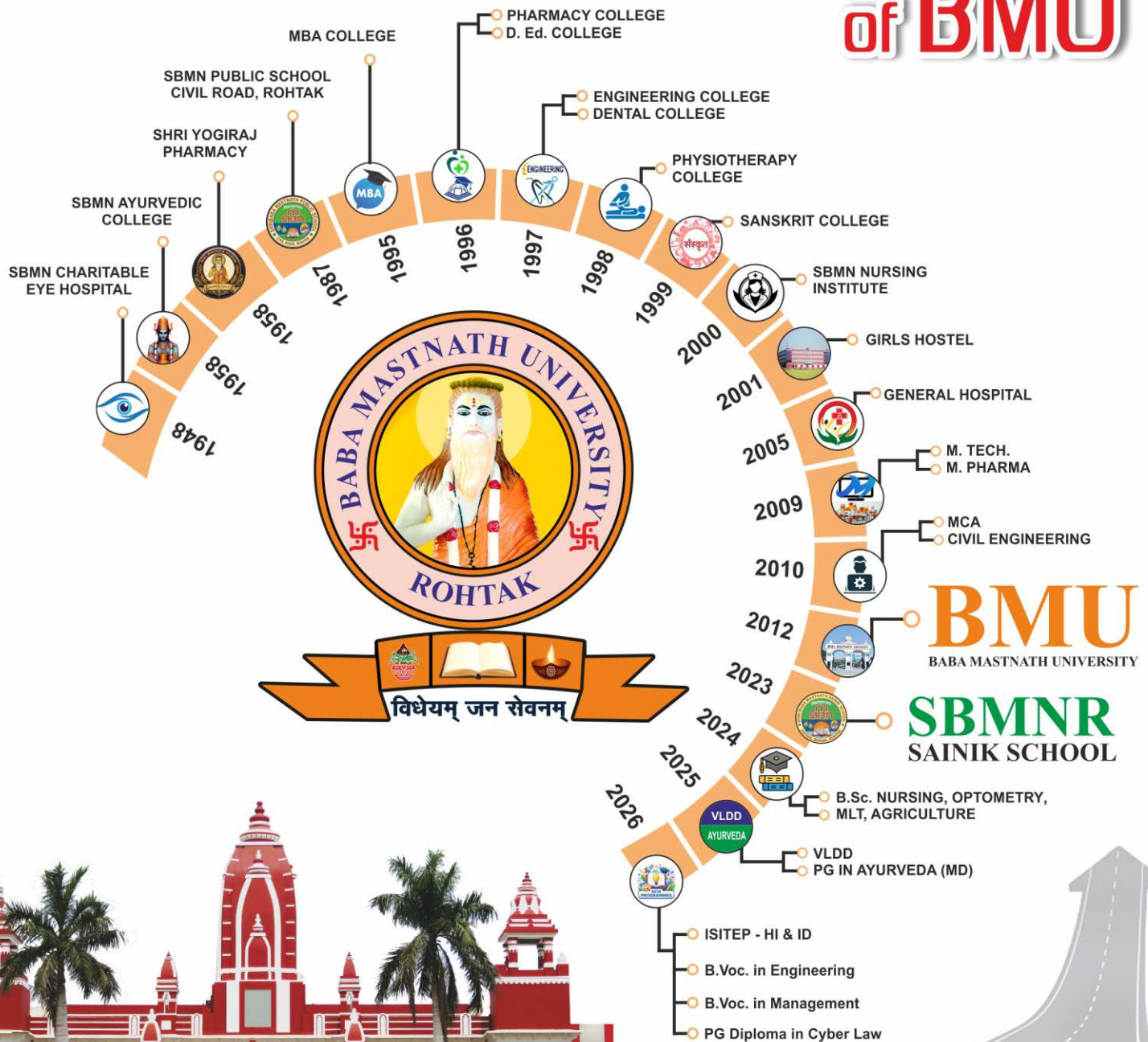

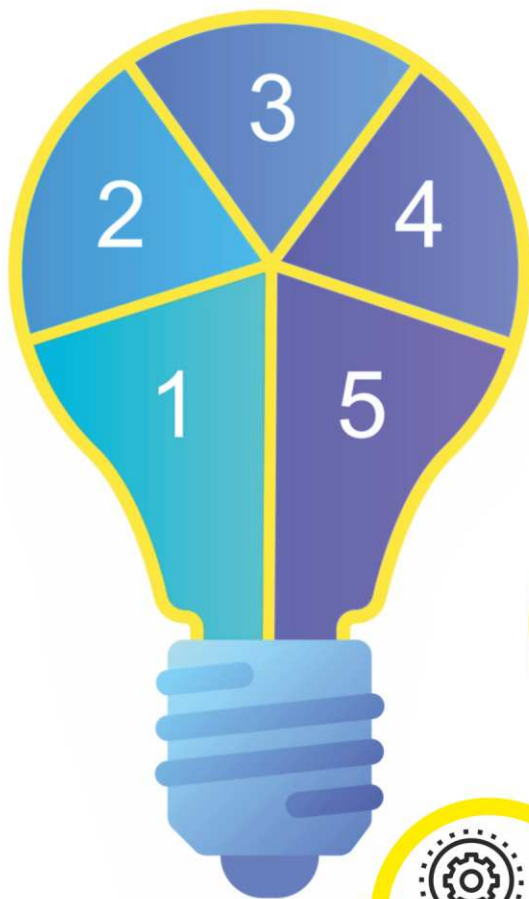

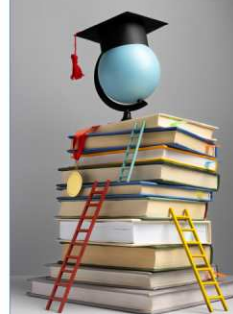

CAMPUS RULES

1. Students are required to be punctual for their classes as well as for seminars, presentations and assessment tests.
2. **Minimum 75% Attendance is compulsory to appear in the University Examination.** Students have to submit leave application giving valid reasons for absence from the classes, to the concerned Dean.
3. Absence from classes for more than 15 days without prior information shall lead to cancellation of the admission of the student and would attract re-admission charges, as may be decided on case to case basis and no fees will be refunded.
4. In case of any document found to be fake or even if the university gives the enrollment due to false documents, the admission will be cancelled with immediate effect and no fees will be refunded.
5. Information regarding examinations, activities etc. shall be displayed on the Notice Boards and shall not be communicated to the students individually. It is the student's responsibility to remain vigilant and visit the University Website/read Notice Board.
6. The request for Change of Branch/Stream shall be processed as per the guidelines of the University.
7. The terms & conditions, rules & regulations and other details shall be amended by the University and shall be available for the students on website (www.bmu.ac.in) of the university.

HOSTEL RULES

1. Students are abide to follow the timings of Hostel as may announced time to time. Beyond the prescribed timings of the Hostel the students will be taken prior permission from the Hostel warden to stay away.
2. All hostlers should seek prior permission of Hostel Warden for going home or to relative's / guardian's house.
3. Use of alcohol and intoxicants of any nature are strictly prohibited. If any student is found guilty, strict disciplinary action (*Fine or Cancellation of Admission*) will be taken.
4. For using any unauthorized gadget/equipment like Heater, Iron, etc. applicable electricity charges shall be deposited by the Hosteller and any outstanding bill amount shall be paid within one month from the due date of bill payment. Otherwise, late fees shall be applicable as per Hostel Rules.
5. Students are advised not to keep excessive cash or valuables with them in the hostel.
6. Students leaving for home must obtain the Outward Pass duly authorized by Warden, and get it signed from their parents, which will be checked on their return.

RULES & REGULATIONS FOR STUDENTS

(All the students are strictly advised to read/understand the Regulations/Rules of the University)

1. Students are not expected to indulge in any unsocial, criminal or political activity, not conforming to their status as students and against the interest of the University.
2. Student found damaging the University property shall be punished & fined and may also be suspended/rusticated from the University and amount of loss incurred shall be recovered from the student.
3. Consumption of tobacco products, alcohol, chewing of gutka, inside the Campus/Hostels is strictly prohibited. Students found consuming these items are liable to be fined and punished. They may even be rusticated.
4. Students shall follow the prescribed Dress Code in the University, Defaulter students would invite heavy fines and will not be allowed to attend the Classes.
5. Students shall be provided with IDENTITY CARD. They are required to wear it always and produce it as and when asked by the authorities. Duplicate cards will be possible on payment of Rs. 200/- or as decided time to time.
6. Gadgets like Mobile Phones, Walkman, Radio, etc. are not allowed inside the classrooms, workshops, seminars, etc. Usage of above will lead to seizure of these gadgets and the same would be released only after payment of fine.

Knowledgeable staff are available to access with research, citations and using our resources effectively.

SPORTS

The Sports facility (Indoor & Outdoor) in the University promotes the spirit of Sports participation among the students. The University organise various activities round the year as per the calendar circulated by the Director, Sports. The University also provide the opportunities to the students to participate in the Inter-Varsity games under the Association of Indian Universities Membership. NCC



The University has two NCC (National Cadet Corps) Units, one for Boys & one for Girls. The NCC is a youth development movements, provides enormous potential for nation building. The NCC provides opportunities to the youth of the country for their all-round development with a sense of Duty, Commitment, Dedication, Discipline and Moral Values so that they become able leaders and useful citizens. The Cadets are given basic military training in small arms and parades. The officers and cadets have no liability for active military service once they complete their course but are given preference over normal candidates during selections based on the achievements in the corps. CDS written exam exemption is given to NCC cadets for SSC recruitment. Special preference is given to NCC cadets at several central and state Government organizations.

AUDITORIUM



The University has two fully air conditioned Auditoriums with having seating capacity of more than 1600 persons. The Auditoriums have audio-visual system with video recording or live-streaming capabilities, stage with podium and proper multi-functional lighting arrangement.

The sound proof auditoriums host numerous events including cultural programmes, lectures and university annual functions. Maximum programs and functions such as presentations, lectures, performances, conferences, seminars, ceremonies, film screenings, community events, religious and spritual geatherings, multimedia demonstrations etc takes place in our auditoriums.

CAFETERIA

University have two cafeterias, one for North campus and South campus. The hospital is having state-of-art gadgets and pieces of equipment. The bed occupancy of the hospital is nearly 60. We offer Glaucoma Diagnostic Surgery, Eye Ultrasound, Squint Surgery, Cornea Diagnostic & Surgery, Retina and Vitreous Diagnostics, Paediatric Ophthalmology, and comprehensive eye examination to our patients.



GENERAL HOSPITAL



Under the aegis of Baba Mastnath Math, the hospital has been serving the needs of students, staff and the surrounding community for more than five decades. The departments of Medicine, Surgery, Dermatology, Gynecology, Orthopaedics, Dentistry, and Paediatrics treats around 500 patients every day at Baba Mastnath Hospital. This 180 bedded hospital is situated in the north campus of Baba Mastnath University providing 24×7 emergency services.

The hospital is well equipped with the latest technological infrastructure providing diagnostic, preventive, and curative services, laboratories, a well-stocked pharmacy, digital X-ray and ultrasound facilities etc. All the doctors are well qualified and experienced supported by nursing and paramedical staff who are well trained and hard working. DENTAL HOSPITAL

There is a Dental hospital which was started in 1997. It has most important dental equipments like RVG and OPG. Nearly 100 patients are provided consultation and treatment in Out Patients Department daily.

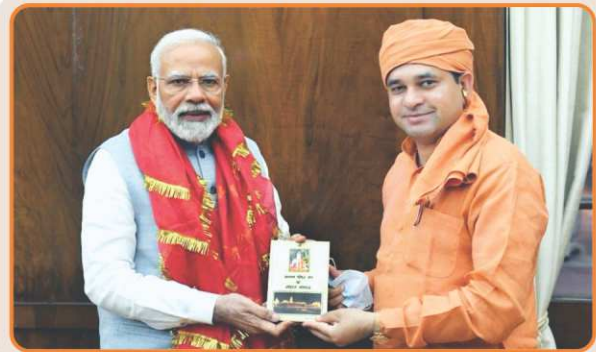
